You will receive an email nearer the time, asking you to confirm which performance you will be attending so that we can ensure there is enough space.



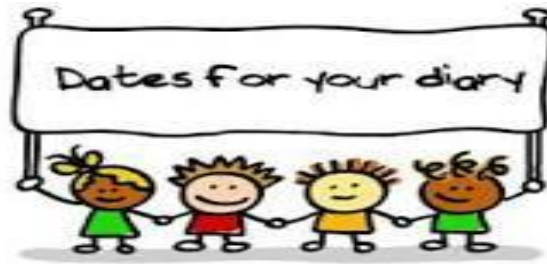
### **Punctuality**
