### **New Head Teacher**

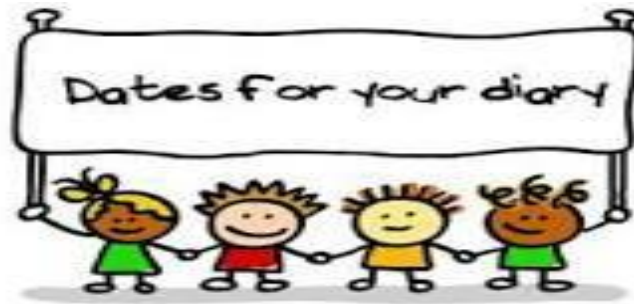
Please look out for Mrs. Martin next week, who will be on the gate all of next week to say hello and familiarise herself with you all.
